FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake in 2018-19 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance in 2019 allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 13, 2019 with 28 Nominations.

Footnotes

SHANCELOT broke on top establishing the front from the get go and crossed directly to the three path, showed the way through swift splits three then two wide through the turn widening away given a notch of rein to work with to a commanding lead coming to the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home at that station, got shaken up to a light drive at the three-sixteenths and forged clear through the stretch being ridden out to the finish. NITROUS just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under urging three furlongs out, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and dug in to be along clear for the place honors well behind the aforementioned foe with no opportunity to even threaten that opponent. HONEST MISCHIEF four paths off the inside in the early going, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths two to three wide as the leader gave

everyone the slip, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid, then weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. SUPER COMET fell to his face at the start losing all footing, the rider and his charge showing great agility to stay upright and onboard while conceding six to seven lengths immediately to the front, chased along the inside from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing tipped three wide three furlongs from home, went seven wide into upper stretch and showed good courage to improve position and secure the last major share. THE BIG S chased along the inside down the backstretch, tipped three wide through the turn coming under urging at the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals through to the finish. BOURBON CALLING two to three wide in pursuit from the tail of the field, tucked inside half a mile from home, got pushed along at the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch and passed tired foes in the drive. ACHILLES WARRIOR hustled from the gate, chased just off the inside through the early stages before tipping four to five wide nearing the turn, came under coaxing four wide at the three-eighths, swung five wide for home and weakened. LEMNISCATE bumped at the start by STRIKE SILVER, who broke outwards, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under a ride at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired. GARTER AND TIE five to six wide in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked two to three wide through the turn coming under a drive with three furlongs to go, went eight wide at the head of the stretch and tired. WENDELL FONG forwardly placed five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, got ridden along at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside for home and faltered in the drive. STRIKE SILVER broke out at the start bumping with LEMNISCATE, chased three to four wide under coaxing from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch, faltered in the stretch, then got pulled up after the finish and was subsequently vanned off. CLASSY JOHN hustled from the start, chased just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, tucked inside into the turn getting pushed along with half a mile to go, retreated steadily nearing the quarter pole and cornered just off the inside at that station, folded, and was eased through to the finish getting pulled up just before the wire.
