

ARCHIDUST was positioned into the three path after the start, ranged up to join the pace dispute after more than halfway around the turn, appeared poised to take control when put to a ride in the general area of the three-sixteenths marker, offered up the desired run and kicked clear. NEVERLAND ROCK (GB) mildly hand urged springing from the starting gate, was out-hoofed for the top by FULLY LOADED, cut over to the inside, kept an eye from the pocket as the front runners vied for command, saw the winner add himself to the pace picture by the five-sixteenths marker, slithered its way to the outside once onto the top of the lane, began the final furlong four wide, finished williingly, although no match today. PYRON assumed a forward position, pressed the issue from the two path, going about the task from between rivals for a furlong beginning from the five-suixteenths marker, was set down spinning into the stretch, put up some fight until deep into the furlnog grounds before tiring. ELEKTRONIC guided over to the inside route after maknig light contact with DUNPH, continued to track the front runners from along the rail, was put to a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, had no rally. THE BLACK ALBUM (FR) set up the two path proceeding on the backstretch, departed it pulling hard and appearing unsettled, was given his cue for the drive home, was moved outward, until approximately six wide late, made no impact. FULLY LOADED grabbed the advantage shortly after the start, went over to the rail by the top of the turn, was shownig the way being pressed by PYRON from the outside when the winner join the pace contest coming up to the five-sixteenths marker, got let loose stepping into the lane, relinquished soon afterwards, weakened steadily thereafter. UNCLE BENNY saw the pilot resort to a hand ride after stumbling badly at the start, got going and was maneuvered into the three path, completed the run around the bend, was worked into path five during the stretch run, had no response. DUNPH took up the chase stationed in the two path in midpack after bumping lightly with ELEKTRONIC in the shadow of the starting gate, tipped sllightly wide spinning into the lane, had no offering and backed away.
