FRONTIER MARKET outward with its initial step, was gathered in by the pilot, took up position in the two path, kept watch well reserved for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest swinging to the outside for the drive, was sighted leaning upon its stablemate settling into the six path at the head of the stretch, teamed up with the that one afterwards rallying in earnest, had the whip get knocked out of the rider 's hand in the general area of the eighth pole, ventured onward with good energy, wrested away the advantage in deep stretch, then edged away, being goggled while crossing the finish line. KEEP QUIET (FR) tucked along the hedge travelling on the homestretch, appeared a bit keen on the bit for a good portion of the run around the clubhouse bend, slipped into the two path, early on the backstretch, drafted behind AVEENU MALCAINU, continued to do so on the next turn, but now from between rivals, stepped into the three path for entrance into the stretch, inched up to the front runners, checked when caught in traffic behind the aforementioned opponent at the furlong grounds, gained a clear alleyway a few strides later when that tiring foe slid over to the inside route, kicked into gear, finished with good energy to procure the place. GEMONTEER broke on top and retained the advantage, got guided over to the inside route, was rated carving out the pace, with the closest pursuer nearby but not latched on, felt an uptick in pressure as three-quarters was being rattled off, got turned loose in response, dug in with good determination with several others eventually taking up the chase, yielded reluctantly a few jumps shy of the wire then got headed for second. UNLEVERAGED pinched after bobbling in the shadow of the starting gate, went over to the hedge, loped along bringing up the back until the conclusion of the backstretch, quickened when let out a notch maneuvering into the three path approaching the five-sixteenths marker, fanned out all the way out to path seven entering the stretch, making some contact with the winner before straightened away, closed with willingness in tandem with FRONTIER MARKET en

route for the last major award. MEMORIES OF PETER was rated in the pocket keeping an eye on the pacesetter, picked it up approaching the quarter pole, out-hoofed AVEENU MALCAINU for path two, put in his best run during the ensuing furlong before flattening out. PENALTY two wide on the first turn, was one path farther off the inside on the subsequent one, was under encouragement angling four wide into the lane, made no headway in the final furlong. LEMONIST three wide on the opening turn, was hung out in path four on turn two, got asked for more right around the five-sixteenths pole, shifted into path five for the drive home, had no rally. AVEENU MALCAINU attended the leader from the two path for six furlongs, stepped into the lane havnig been called upon a sixteenth up the road, appeared through by the eighth pole, altered over to the rail afterwards, providing, as it turned out, KEEP QUIET access to its path and clearance then backed away steadily.
