MIND CONTROL off the inside throughout, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, got called upon at the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch by angling four wide, was part of a hoarde on near even terms with each other chasing SHANCELOT traversing through the furlong grounds, closed in relentlessly, getting up in the last jump. HOG CREEK HUSTLE departed the backstretch from path three, bided time towards the back of the pack for the opening half and a bit beyond, got roused moving to the outside late on the bend, wound up six wide, becoming the widest of all, took off in earnest after the leader, closed the gap with good late energy, missed. SHANCELOT emerged from a bunched up cluster of equines holding a slim advantage by the end of the chute, extended it out to as much a body length prior to the first fraction being finalized, showed the way, spaced at a slight distance from off the rail and with CALL PAUL in accompaniment to the outside, arrived at the quarter pole with several of the closest pursuers already being feverishly ridden, spun into the lane, ventured onward ridden out for the next sixteenth before getting switched over to a drive, began the last eighth leading by his biggest margin, saw it dwindle down steadily thereafter, was almost there but got nailed. ROWAYTON two wide onto the turn, swung five wide exiting it, narrowed in displaying some willingness to secure the last major check. NITROUS guided over to the inside route coming up to the beginning of the backstretch, remained on it tracking the front runners, was angled five wide for the drive home, rallied mildly, but all accomplished with little impact. CALL PAUL prompted SHANCELOT from the two path, kept close enough to that rival to apply some pressure for the opening half, even with the tempo having picked up significantly, got set down spinning into the stretch, continued along prominently placed for another furlong before weakening. BORRACHO cut over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, took it until the end of the bend, tipped into the two path at the head of the stretch, tired leaving the eighth pole. THE BIG S

took up the chase from path two on the turn, got roused shortly after the half had been completed, gave way down the lane. TWELFTH LABOUR saved ground, cut the corner under a drive, faltered.
