## Footnotes

GEMONTEER took over outside FROSTMOURNE as a dawdling first quarter-mile was unfolding, moved inside nursed along through the middle stages, kicked clear eagerly into the stretch and held PROJECTED at bay under clever rating. PROJECTED (GB) raced close-up from the outset, was boxed in along the rail around the far turn behind the leaders, kicked in strongly while moving out for clearance a sixteenth out but could not reach the winner. GUNNISON steadied slightly outside FROSTMOURNE midway on the first turn, stayed mostly three wide to the stretch and finished up one-paced. FROSTMOURNE broke on top, became very rank when displaced by GEMONTEER on the first turn, moved well out in the course as the rider attempted to settle him down, shadowed the pacesetter to the stretch and weakened through the last eighth of a mile. STIRLING DRIVE saved ground on the turns, moved out widest for the drive and made no headway.
