DYNADRIVE broke outwards brushing ROCK THE PARK, was collected, then reserved along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out after a half while continuing under patient handling, swung out four, then five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to just prevail in time under firm handling. ANGELUS WARRIOR, bumped at the start, angled to the rail in early stages tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance under light rating, saved ground on the far turn gathering momentum, shifted out racing into the lane to bid for command between foes, shifted out late resisting the winner's challenge grudgingly to the end and just missed. ME AND MR. C sped to the fore from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin inside a rival for five furlongs, dispatched that foe on the far turn, then dueled inside foes through the stretch, resisting the top pair to late stages. HIGH HEATER broke inwards bumping ANGELUS WARRIOR, was settled last early, angled to the inside gaining position racing into the far turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes in upper stretch but had no final kick. IRISH EXPECTATIONS, forwardly placed outside foes tracking just off the pace, moved to briefly challenge the pacesetter while shifting inwards racing into the far turn but quickly flattened out. ROCK THE PARK, squeezed a bit at the start, was urged to terms prompting the pacesetter racing to the far turn and gave way early.
