Footnotes

NEVERSTOPDREAMING bumped with NIMBLE BEAST at the start, pressed the pace outside YOUNG RAYMOND in the three-path, took over in upper stretch and drove clear. YOUNG RAYMOND sprinted clear soon after the start, went along pressed from both flanks around the turn two wide, could not withstand the winner by midstretch but held well on the rail to best the others. ALL POWER steadied inside at the nine-sixteenths, remained hemmed in through most of the second quarter-mile before finally checking and going around three wide at the top of the stretch, and could not gain once clear. L' CRISTABAL lacked early speed inside, swung to the far outside for the drive and improved past tired horses. NIMBLE BEAST bumped with the eventual winner at the start, felt the whip before reaching the turn but had no response. GRAND MORELAND bobbled and steadied back to last at the start, split horses advancing into the turn, and backpedaled three wide before reaching the stretch. CONQUER broke on top despite a bit of a bobble, then was soon outsprinted, dropped back steadily on the turn and was eased up in the lane.
