THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, December 8. \$1,000 to enter. \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds: 124 lbs. Older: 126 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes since June 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a graded stakes in 2019 or a stakes race since April 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners in 2018-19, graded stakes placed in 2018-19 then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner.

Footnotes

DIAMOND OOPS was allowed to settle off the early pace, began moving three wide after a torrid half-mile, rallied steadily forging past IMPERIAL HINT from the outside into the final furlong, and edged away. LASTING LEGACY trailed up the backstretch inside, shifted out beginning to get in gear past the five-sixteenths, came four wide into the lane and finished with good courage on the wrong lead. IMPERIAL HINT chased outside X Y JET for a half, reeled that one in past the quarter-pole and kicked clear at the top of the stretch, could not stave off DIAMOND OOPS through the furlong grounds and lost the place late. ZENDEN bumped hard with X Y JET at the start, chased three then four wide to the end of the turn, and faded. HOME BASE showed some early speed inside, but dropped back through the turn and continued to fade away. X Y JET bumped solidly with ZENDEN at the start, sped to a clear lead through blazing early fractions, relinquished command to IMPERIAL HINT approaching the stretch, and faltered inside.
