## **Footnotes**

NOBLE DRAMA put in a sharp four-wide move to contention late on the turn, shifted further out collaring BOURBON WAR in upper stretch, and kicked away in the middle of the track. GREEN MANSIONS rallied on the far turn but was out-moved by the eventual winner going by the quarter-pole, and ran on with good courage to get the place. BOURBON WAR stayed close early, was driven four wide through the turn to gain command just after going six furlongs, shifted inward and weakened through the late stages barely saving the show spot. SCARS ARE COOL came four wide beginning to find his best stride into the stretch, rallied mildly through the furlong grounds, then lugged in a bit late. CHAMPAGNEONME was outrun for six furlongs, swung five wide for the drive and improved position outside. UNCLE MOJO delayed the start reluctant to load and a bit fractious, came away in good order and tracked the leaders three wide, lodged a brief bid on the turn but gave way with five-sixteenths remaining. MAGIC TAPIT dueled for command outside BABY I'M PERFECT to the far turn, could not fend off challengers past the quarter-pole and retreated. BABY I'M PERFECT vied inside MAGIC TAPIT early, and backpedaled on the turn. COLOUR GUARD broke through the gate prior to the start, came away without incident, saved ground in range to the stretch before tiring, and was eased up late. IDENTIFIER was finished early, and eased up in the stretch.
