

SILVER RATIO was away in good order and hustled along in steady pursuit racing off the top two leaders, gained position around the turn then entered top stretch five wide, advanced under left handed pressure to race in striking distance of MR. PHILLY DILLY in final furlong, vied in late stages, kept on determinedly, wrested the advantage nearing the wire and edged away. MR. PHILLY DILLY raced near the lead out of the gate and angled to the inside, continued behind the leader then prompted and advanced to assume command mid-way through the turn, was under attack from oncoming SILVER RATIO turning for home and came under right handed encouragement, kept on gamely and maintained a narrow lead, vied in late stages then lacked a closing kick and cleared the rest. SAG HARBOR raced five wide off the early speed, pushed along five wide around the turn, was set down for the drive, drifted out wider under right handed pressure, was no match for the top pair but kept on game for a placing and got up for show. TIO WIL hustled along in steady pursuit in early stages and switched in to race two wide leaving the backstretch, pushed along around the turn and entered top stretch two wide then came out bit wider, stayed on with interest under steady pressure and got edged out late for show. GUACO got bumped at the start and dropped back, saved ground and advanced position around the turn, cut the corner and continued with response upper stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. ROGUE ELEMENT was off a step slow at the start, raced off the pace and saved ground in early stages then angled out, raced wide in the stretch run and lacked the needed response for impact. AWAKENED got bumped back and lost all momentum at the start, trailed then passed a few faders in the lane. BOURBON STREET raced off the pace and saved ground to no avail. BYCHANCE sped to the lead, continued on top into the turn, got collared near the five sixteenths
