NY TRAFFIC cleared on top and angled to the inside just after the start, secured inside position and set a pressured pace with GENGHIS not far behind, repelled bids from challenger's and took a clearer advantage around the turn, was put to a drive at head of the lane, responded sharply and finished going away. MASTERDAY got bumped just out of the gate, was forwardly placed around the first turn and tracked the pace along the inside down the backstretch, switched out a path and launched a bid moving through the final turn, was no match for the winner but continued a steady bid and just lasted for place. SOUNION broke in and bumped with foe at the start, raced in close contention and stalked the top two leaders positioned three wide down the backstretch, picked up the pace along the outside around the turn, sustained bid in stretch run and captured show. TIZ RYE TIME raced inside and settled off the early leaders, hustled up leaving the backstretch then was put to a drive along the rail around the far turn, switched out wider for the stretch run, stayed on with response and got edged out late for share. MOON OVER MIAMI raced six wide entering the first turn, stayed outside and rated off the early pace, raced seven wide under pressure at head of the lane and lacked the needed response for late impact. GANGLY raced five wide entering the first turn, was allowed to settle and raced in the back near the inside to the far turn, moved into top stretch eight wide and lacked a needed rally. GENGHIS was forwardly placed in opening stages and prompted the pace down the backstretch, launched a bid for command upon entering the far turn, failed to reach the winner then steadily weakened. LURE HIM IN got bumped between foes just out of the gate, settled nicely while rated off the early pace, hustled along to pick up the tempo past the half mile marker, failed to advance around the far turn then offered no late rally.
