## **Footnotes**

FACTORINO was sent hard at the start and held a slim lead then cleared on top and held firm along the inside around the turn, was put to a drive near the furlong marker, dug in gamely with ears pinned back and just lasted over gaining UNION COLONEL. UNION COLONEL was forwardly placed up the inside in opening stages, remained in close contention under some mild prompting around the turn, came under strong left handed pressure upper stretch, drifted out while gaining on FACTORNO, was getting to the winner in final strides and just missed. THE VIRGINIAN raced off the pace in opening stages and dropped to the inside to save ground, was patiently handled around the turn, shifted out and hustled along at head of the lane, moved out wider while positioned behind drifting out UNION COLONEL and continued a steady late effort for show. LONELY PRIVATE hustled up from the get-go and raced in

range early on, moved through the turn three to four wide then got carried wide into stretch and lost ground, switched in a few paths and gained position late. MR NAPPY moved in from the outside moving through the backstretch, raced off the early pace and saved ground around the turn, hustled along into stretch run, had a mild improve and finished on equal terms with STRONG ENDING. STRONG ENDING bumped the gate and raced off the early speed, hustled along the outside around the turn, moved into stretch wide then switched in a few paths, produced a mild bid and finished on equal terms with MR NAPPY. MUKULWITZ lacked early foot and raced in the back, left the backstretch three wide and urged around the turn, kept under steady pressure and passed tiring foes in the lane. LASTING IMAGE raced in the last flight, was under a ride four to five wide in the lane and lacked the needed response for late impact. DR. DOYLE showed response in opening stages then lost position around the turn, chased on two wide upper stretch and lacked a needed rally. PALACE KID raced in close contention of the early leader, remained in a forward position and chased after the eventual winner into upper stretch then came up empty in the final furlong. BLOODPROF hustled along and positioned as a strong contender in early stages then flattened out around the turn and offered no late rally. SAGAMORE MISCHIEF lacked early foot and dropped over to the inside to save ground, was under a ride racing three wide upper stretch but failed to kick on.
