STORM RISK was allowed to settle early two to three wide, angled widest leaving the far turn, and surged late on the far outside to overtake CROI MOR in the closing strides. CROI MOR stalked the leaders outside, bid three wide at the top of the lane, forged clear in deep stretch but could not hold off the top one. FARM STRONG came under a ride midway on the far turn three wide, gained only minimally into the stretch, then found his best stride late to be along for the show. AT THE BEACH pressed the pace outside SULTANNES CROWN, reached a short lead approaching the stretch, but weakened in the late stages. SULTANNES CROWN set a brisk early pace inside, battled on in the two-path turning for home, but weakened through the last furlong. TAP MEMORIES found his way to the inside early, lodged a mild bid along the rail through the furlong grounds but did not have enough late. STILL SCHEMIN saved ground outrun for six furlongs, angled wide into the stretch and gained mildly. LOVEDISC broke open the gate unseating the rider prior to the start, got away without further incident, raced two wide on the turns, and was in traffic not fully set down through the last sixteenth of a mile. AVANT GARDE had the rail on the turns, moved to the two-path at the top of the lane and posed no threat. ROAN MOUNTAIN was outrun inside. ULTRACONFIDENT raced

widest up the backstretch, and was done before reaching the stretch. FRANCO'S TEAM broke open the gate prior to the start, lost contact with the field
early, was pulled up early on the backstretch, and walked off.
