Footnotes

EMOJI GUY raced in striking range from the outset, got roused outside the quarter-pole three wide, kicked in to reel in BEE MAJOR through mid stretch and

drove clear. TRACEABILITY bumped with CLIFTON PARK at the start, saved ground to the far turn in the second flight, moved out for the drive and finished with good courage between horses to get the place. STRONG HEADED lacked room after the start, then steadied again through the stretch the first time, angled out leaving the far turn and gained late on the far outside. BEYOND THE CALL saved ground to the stretch, moved to the two-path with a mild run through the furlong grounds, and was outfinished. BIG TREASURE saved ground to the stretch, moved off the rail a sixteenth out and showed some late interest. BEE MAJOR cleared to the lead around the first turn, rated along inside to the stretch, and gave way through the last eighth of a mile. HERO UP prompted the pace outside BEE MAJOR for six furlongs, and tired in the stretch. CLIFTON PARK got bumped between horses at the start, steadied along the inside nearing the first turn, and lacked the needed late response. HELL BENT was never a factor. AVANT GARDE went into the first turn extremely wide, moved in a bit up the backstretch and could not reach contention. NIMBLE BEAST bumped with CLIFTON PARK at the start, was four then three wide on the first turn, and was finished early.
