STILL SCHEMIN was well placed tracking the embattled par down the backstretch, advanced three to the lead late on the far turn then stayed sharp and clear through the lane. MAYITO rated not too far back early on, roused three to four wide on the far turn then dug in gamely to hold place. CUY got carried out wide entering the first turn, launched a bid on the far turn, was under a drove four wide entering the lane, stayed on with response and lasted for show. FARM STRONG was unhurried then raced wide into the lane, moved in a couple paths, continued a steady bid and just missed show. CLIFTON PARK rated three wide off the early pace, launched a bid and raced five wide entering top stretch then lugged in under left handed urging and flattened out.

SUPER EDGAR raced off the pace then shifted wide near mid-stretch and passed tiring foes. MOUNTAIN TREE was unhurried and saved ground, angled out three to four wide in stretch run and failed to rally. WE CONNECTED raced in contention then was awkward in stride past the three eighths pole and gave way. RAPSTOREROCKS vied for the lead along the inside to late on the final turn then tired in the drive. HELL BENT raced in the back and failed to move into contention. ELITE MISSION drifted out five wide entering the first turn, vied for the lead down the backstretch then got collared past the quarter pole and tired in the drive. FUEGO raced off the pace then five to six wide into the stretch and offered no late bid.
