Footnotes

BAYOU PROSPECTOR raced under a snug hold and settled off the pace to the far turn, let out a notch and raced along the inside before angling out wider leaving the final turn, was set down five wide for the drive, stayed on determinedly while edging up closer under strong handling and got up late. STRONG HEADED settled off the early pace to the far turn, picked up the tempo and fanned out wide entering the top stretch then rallied along the far outside and

captured place. DR. DOYLE stalked behind the leader down the backstretch then edged closer around the far turn, roused forward and took the lead near the eighth pole then got outfinished. SPIRITUAL KING sprinted to the lead and held firm around the far turn, got headed for the lead by DR. DOYLE near the furlong grounds and gave way. RATIFY got bumped and steadied on the first turn then saved ground while settled off the pace, angled out a few paths in stretch run and had a mild improve. STONECASTLE slammed the gate at the start then got carried out wide on the first turn, raced off the pace then roused along the inside upper stretch, showed response but needed more. FORK UNION was unhurried, raced two wide at the quarter pole then wider in the drive and failed to threaten. MORE THAN USUAL tracked the pace and continued forwardly placed into upper stretch then gave way. INCONVEYANCE raced in range and three wide around the far turn then weakened in the lane. UNCLE FESTER got bumped into and forced out on the first turn then failed to move into contention. U S S COLTON raced off the pace and had no late response. YANKEE EMPIRE brushed with the rail in opening stages then tugged on the bit while keen and steadied along into the backstretch then had no response when called upon.
