Footnotes

HARD LIGHTING hit the right side of the gate at the start, rallied in the two-path to collar HARPER from the inside after six furlongs, drew clear through mid stretch, and was all out to hold on. LEADING WEST saved ground unhurried early, swung out four wide leaving the turn, rallied steadily and was getting to the winner from outside. METCALFE raced four wide and failed to menace. HARPER pressed BLOODPROF from outside early, took over midway on the turn and briefly drew clear, was overhauled from both sides at the top of the stretch, and retreated. COURAGE brushed the left side of the gate and was away slowly, moved up through the opening stages, but was finished before reaching the stretch. BLOODPROF set the pace well off the rail to turn, yielded to HARPER with three furlongs remaining, and was eased up in the stretch.
