NOTSOSUBTLE vied outside BEBEAU for the better part of six furlongs, took over four paths out turning for home, and drew off under a drive. BEBEAU was off the rail dueling for command inside NOTSOSUBTLE up the backstretch and into the turn, could not match strides past the quarter-pole, and ran on to hold the place. STILL SCHEMIN stayed in range four wide early, and faded on the wrong lead while able to salvage the show. RARE HUE saved ground to no avail. OLE MOLE followed behind the battling leaders to the turn, and faded before reaching the stretch. JUAN BOLY was taken widest early, put in a brief run five wide on the turn, faded in upper stretch and was eased up late.
