SUMMER ASSAULT was rated just off the pacesetter while angling to the rail racing into the first turn, continued under patient handling into the far turn, came through when presented an opening to challenge for command inside rivals in upper stretch then edged forward late under firm handling and some right handed pressure. ANGELUS WARRIOR was rated between foes in second flight tracking the leaders into the backstretch, shifted out three deep entering the far turn advancing on the leaders, moved to challenge for command while drifting out in upper stretch and contested the issue to late stages while just failing to match the winner. CREATIVE PLAN, in touch from the outset attending a rival's pace under light reserve racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn into the lane and grudgingly resisted the top pair while being just outkicked. BAYOU PROSPECTOR settled along the inside tracking off the second flight, angled out nearing the lane to race five wide through the stretch and made some mild progress late. PLANE TALK, urged to dictate the pace on a narrow margin while angling to the rail racing to the first turn, dueled for command inside rivals into the far turn and gave way between foes leaving midstretch. HONDO LANE tracked off the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded into the stretch. WILD TONIGHT, forwardly placed three wide tracking just off the leaders to the backstretch, gave way nearing the far turn.
