HAPPY SAVER forwardly placed along the inside from the gate, was taken hold of when put in a bit tight into the first turn by HIGH AMPLITUDE, tracked along the rail through the opening bend and down the backstretch patiently handled, remained along the fence through the far turn until placed to coaxing and angled off the inside five-sixteenths from home, went six wide into upper stretch put to a drive, rallied to collar the leader a furlong from home, then drew clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages to the finish. BEAU LUMINARIE three wide through the first turn, raced four wide in pursuit from mid pack albeit in striking range of the front, began an advance on the leader in tandem with HIGH AMPLITUDE to his inside at the seven-sixteenths coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, stacked outside the top pair, cornered four wide for home, took over the front straightened away, dug in under threat and was displaced just inside the eighth pole, kept on to secure the place honors clear of the rest while no match for the top one through the final furlong. HIGH AMPLITUDE tucked briefly to the two path putting HAPPY SAVER in a bit tight briefly into the first turn before tipping three wide through the rest of the bend, raced three to four paths off the inside in closest aim of the leader advancing to latch on that rival five furlongs from home, remained three wide through the far turn and issued a challenge to the front between foes coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, continued three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the final eighth while along for the show honors. AMANI'S EAGLE brushed the near side stall at the start and established the front shortly after, showed the way in hand just off the inside through the first turn and down the backstretch safely in front until engaged with some pressure at the five-eighths as the aforementioned foe latched on to the outside, remained just off the inside through the far turn and came under threat from a pair three furlongs out, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home heads apart for command, yielded the front straightened away and tired. BASQUIAT just off the inside through the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch, came under coaxing three to four wide at the three-eighths, angled in to cut the corner into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact. FAMILY BIZ saved ground in the early stages, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths and got out four to five wide through the far turn, swung six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SUMMER KID three wide into the first turn, tucked to the two path and was loosely between foes facing some kickback and pulled on the bit unsettled under a firm hold by the rider, remained rating unkindly down the backstretch two to three wide while kept behind cover of rivals, began to get shaken off midway on the far turn when put to urging while three wide, offered no response and went four wide for home and was eased through the stretch while being periodically flashed the stick to the off side.
