R MAN JOE vied outside DISCREET TUNE and WEEKEND DREAMER early, took over at the top of the stretch kicking away, and drifted out late while clear. BLOODPROF saved ground into the turn, came two wide rallying into the lane, and finished willingly inside to take the place battle. LASCARI (GB) was a step slow at the start, shifted out five wide approaching the stretch, and rallied outside just missing second. DON V. stayed in range three then four wide to the head of the lane, and lacked a solid closing bid. JOE BENJAMIN saved ground on the turn, moved out a bit and gained mildly without threatening. DISCREET TUNE vied inside rivals early, and was outpaced through the latter part of the turn. PRO QUALITY walked out of the gate four to five lengths behind the others, and was always outrun. WEEKEND DREAMER argued the early pace between rivals, yielded to the winner turning for home, and retreated.
