STAKES Tropical Park Derby Listed - Thoroughbred

THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, December 13. \$750 to enter. A supplemental nomination fee of \$100 may be made prior to closing time of entries. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of stakes race at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 4 lbs.; such a race at a mile or over, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to stakes winners, stakes placed then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 108 feet).



COLONEL LIAM settled off the early pace while racing three wide, cruised up four deep around the far turn, seized command approaching the lane, quickly cleared and widened under left-handed urging. DON JUAN KITTEN advanced two wide to the lead around the first turn, angled in early on the backstretch, set the pace along the rail from there until collared by the winner turning for home and fought on willingly to save second. SUMMER TO REMEMBER led early, settled back into a stalking position inside, angled out in upper stretch and battled between rivals to gain the show. BY YOUR SIDE tracked the pace two wide, checked late on the first turn, remained in range three deep around the far turn, angled wider in upper stretch and was outkicked outside of foes for the minor awards. FANCY LIQUOR was up close four wide around the first turn, remained in range three wide between foes around the far turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. SOLE VOLANTE saved ground off the pace, angled three wide near the quarter pole and went evenly. ANGELUS WARRIOR saved ground around the turns and played no factor. ME AND MR. C lacked early speed while racing two wide, went four wide around the far turn, continued on the left lead in the lane and never threatened. FIGHTING SEABEE steadied off heels early, raced three and four wide and made little impact. DACK JANIEL'S prompted the pace three then two wide and retreated after six furlongs.
