Footnotes

CHARLIECANDO went along in the three-path within range, bid between horses approaching the stretch, dueled late inside COACH PAUL and took a narrow decision. COACH PAUL raced three to four wide in midpack early, joined the leaders approaching the stretch, had aim outside CHARLIECANDO through the furlong grounds and just missed. MY COUSIN JOE was in some traffic midway on the far turn, shifted out four wide into the lane, and offered a mild response to pick up the show. FORTY FLASH grabbed the lead with an alert start, showed the way near the inside to the far turn, got hooked into the stretch and weakened. REINOANIMAUX got bumped by UNCUT GEM at the break and was slow to get going, went four wide around the first turn at the back, put in a mild run coming off the far turn three wide, but did not have enough to threaten. MAYOR REMO pressed the pace outside for a half-mile, and lacked the needed response. INACCEPTABLE was strung out five wide on the first turn, moved up to force the pace outside into the backstretch, but weakened on the far turn. OUTDOOR DINING was no factor inside. UNCUT GEM broke out bumping REINOANIMAUX at the start, and was outrun. GRAN PATRON was never prominent. UNDER FIRE broke slowly and was always outrun. ARMALITE was four wide early, and retired after a half.
