ROD TWO ROD got bumped at the start then tracked the pace through the backstretch, launched a three wide bid for the embattled duo midway around the far turn, ran on four wide into the lane, dug in determinedly in pursuit of DOMINICAN ICE in the final furlong and got by rival in deep stretch. DOMINICAN ICE got bumped at the start then set a pressured pace, began to duel for the lead outside of LOGICO at the half mile marker, battled on around the turn then shook free turning for home, stayed on gamely, held a slim lead with a sixteenth left to run then got wore down by the winner. LOGICO applied pace pressure to DOMINICAN ICE in early stages then matched strides for the lead going by the half mile marker, battled on around the far turn, could not maintain equal terms turning for home but stayed on with response and just lasted for show. DOWN TO BIZZNESS tracked the pace through early stages, hustled up along the rail around the turn, stayed near the inside through the lane and just missed show. BLIND EYE veered out and bumped with rivals at the start, raced in range then came under a ride two wide around the far turn, came out wider for the drive and failed to kick on. CASSIDYS GOLD got bumped at the start and raced off the pace, came two to three wide into the lane and had no response. RED ROAD got bumped at the start, was forwardly placed through the backstretch then retreated entering the far turn. ONE MORE DAY got bumped between rivals at the start, was reserved in the back and never reached contention.
