Footnotes

KATIES A LADY switched out in the opening stages stalking the pacesetter outside a rival under light rating to the backstretch, readily advanced outside that foe to gain a clear advantage entering the second bend, opened a commanding margin racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm left handed pressure. SUSANS NOVELA tracked off the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, tipped out nearing the second bend, was shuffled a bit avoiding close quarters on the far turn, continued between foes through that bend, then angled three wide entering the stretch while finishing with interest to prove best of the others. SCOOP THERE IT IS tracked off the second flight outside a rival from just out of striking distance in the opening half, switched outside a tiring foe while being prompted in pursuit of the winner into the far turn, angled to the inside nearing the lane and continued evenly in late stages while prevailing for a share. SUMMER HELPER, reserved between foes, then along the inside racing into the backstretch, was taken in hand, then altered course to race four wide avoiding traffic entering the far turn, then continued in that path to the closing stages while making an effort to improve position. PERGOLA angled to the inside tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, then steadily faded along the rail nearing the lane. ROYAL ROCKER was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, continued three wide between foes racing through the far turn but offered no rally. MURUMBI settled last along the inside racing to the far turn and proved no threat. STERLINA sprinted to the lead shifting a bit off the rail racing into the first turn, set the pace through the backstretch and gave out abruptly nearing the three furlong marker.
