TALLAHATCHIEBRIDGE settled off the pace inside, angled three wide near the quarter pole, closed outside, was up near the sixteenth pole and readily drew off. GRAND DAVID bumped with TRENDING at the start, stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, vied two wide down the backstretch and around the far turn, put away the pace rival in midstretch but could not withstand the winner's late charge. RACKET set the pace along the rail, fought on inside of GRAND DAVID to midstretch and just lasted for the show. TRENDING bumped with GRAND DAVID at the start, steadied nearing the first turn, saved ground off the pace, tipped out in the stretch, rallied between foes late and just missed third. NATIVE THUNDER was off slow, raced well back two wide, tipped out in upper stretch and had a mild rally. MAD MOCHA failed to menace while racing two and three wide. FLASH FROST played no factor while racing two and three wide. SIR SAMUEL tracked the pace three wide and was through after a half. SUPERSTITIEUX was outrun while racing three and four wide.
