Footnotes

NATHAN DETROIT saved ground early while in range and under some rating, eased out and edged up between runners into the far turn, was kept in by BROKER'S REWARD when trying to advance three wide in upper stretch, altered in towards the rail soon after, bid inside the leaders past the furlong grounds, gained a slim advantage in deep stretch and prevailed following a steady drive. SIGILOS0 rated in range while outside a rival, moved up into the far turn, was put to a hard ride leaving the three eighths, bid three wide outside the leader with a quarter to go, exchanged a brush with KING'S HONOUR dueling in upper stretch, gained a slim lead a furlong out, lost command in deep stretch, made one last lunge but just missed in a gritty effort. KING'S HONOR (IRE) cleared early, was nursed along two wide on the front end, braced for a challenge nearing the lane, brushed with SIGILOS0 soon into the stretch, fought on after being headed in mid stretch, stayed on to late then gave way grudgingly. BROKER'S REWARD rated off the inside while trailing, circled four wide making some headway into the stretch, continued progress outside rivals past the sixteenth pole then failed to seriously sustain. CLOSER LOOK was hustled up soon after the break and stalked the pace, saved ground while under pressure leaving the far turn, chased inside rivals and faded.
