EXTRA INDY was bumped soon after the start, saved ground off the pace, closed along the rail in the lane, reached near even terms nearing the sixteenth pole and won the late duel. SHILOH steadied at the start, was bumped leaving the chute, raced off the pace five wide, bid outside of foes nearing the sixteenth pole and was narrowly outkicked in a game try. NICE BABY stumbled and bumped BULLET VALENTINA at the start but was still quickly in front, set the pace in the two path, led to the sixteenth pole and weakened between the top two finishers. MARVELOUS LADY prompted the pace three wide to midstretch and faded. GRATIA threw her head at the start and broke a clear last, trailed in the four path for a half, angled widest in upper stretch and passed tiring rivals. DORTH VADER stumbled badly then veered out at the start, came back in and bumped SHILOH leaving the chute, raced up close four wide and came up empty in the lane. BULLET VALENTINA was bumped at the start, raced two wide and never threatened. TOO MUCH VINO was bumped soon after the start, raced three wide and made little impact.
