## Footnotes

LADY AZTECA saved ground around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the inside for the run up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn, launched a bid from the rail in upper stretch and pulled clear to the wire while drifting out mildly late. MORGAN'S BLUFF raced in the two path around the first turn, continued up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the three path, swung wide entering the stretch, and gained ground in late stretch. NUWANDA saved ground around the first turn, raced off pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the three and four path, swung wide entering the stretch and gained ground late. BALI BALIFLY saved ground around the first turn, chased the leader up the backstretch, began to improve position while running in the two path around the far turn, led the field in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong while drifting out. ZITA OF BOURBON stumbled mildly while racing in the three path around the turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch and around the far turn and finished evenly. BANK BUSTER saved ground in the middle of the pack through the opening half mile, moved up to challenge from the three path coming around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. HAINT BLUE hopped up slightly leaving the gate, trailed the field while saving ground around the first turn and up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn and passed tiring horses in the stretch while never threatening. MISS GRAND SLAM saved ground around the first turn, raced inside up the backstretch, moved up slightly while coming around the far turn and faded from there. AIR ONE led the field from the three path around the first turn, opened up coming up the backstretch, angled in to save ground around the second bend, folded entering the stretch and tired to the wire.
