BOARDWALK FRIES raced in the three path around the first turn, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, moved up while saving ground around the far bend, gained ground between horses in the stretch and pulled clear late. ZIPPY ZINNY bumped with the horse to her inside at the start, raced in the middle of the pack on the outside through the opening half mile, continued around the far turn in the two path and gained ground in late stretch. MS EXCUSE saved ground early, raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn, began a bid passing the quarter pole and kept on to the wire. HIGH DONNA bumped mildly with the horse to her outside leaving the gate, recovered to lead the field while saving ground around the first turn and up the backstretch, dueled from the rail around the far bend and chase on late. INSATIABLE EVA raced in the three path around the first bend, settled at the back of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, came around the far turn in the five path and improved position in the lane. SARA KALI raced in the three path early, chased the leader up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the four path and

was outkicked in the stretch. MISS NEO was fractious in the gate, bobbled slightly at the break, raced off the pace on the outside through the opening half mile, continued around the far turn still in the three path and never threatened. ROYALE FLARE raced at the back of the pack on the inside around the first turn and up the backstretch, came around the second bend in the four path and showed no kick. ITRIEDSELLINGHER saved ground early, trailed the field up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the second turn and made no bid. FINAL NOTE was rank coming by the stands for the first time, blew the turn, was pulled up by her rider and walked off.
