Footnotes

COCO tracked the pace three wide, moved to the front leaving the five-sixteenths marker and drew off under a drive. CALLING ALL ANGELS (IRE) stalked the pace two wide, bid between foes midway around the far turn, briefly led, but was no match for the winner. LADY AZTECA raced off the pace two wide, advanced two wide between rivals around the far turn, tipped out in upper stretch and held the show. ZOSTEROP chased the pace inside, could not keep pace rounding the far turn, tipped out in upper stretch and improved position. STUCK IN MALIBU failed to menace while racing two and three wide. BLACK ICE was outrun inside. X Y LADY set the pace in the two path around the first turn and along the rail into the far turn and faltered nearing the quarter pole.
