MISS MARY NELL stalked the pace three wide, took over in upper stretch and drew off under a drive. LE TOUCHE bumped with OCEAN STAR at the start, saved ground in range, swung four wide in upper stretch and finished willingly to be clearly second best. BELLE MIA trailed inside, made progress at the rail around the far turn and was along for the show. CHEESE pressed the pace two wide and weakened in the drive. CAJUN PRIME set the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch. OCEAN STAR bumped at the start, raced off the pace two and three wide and lacked a closing bid. PRAYED FOR GIRL played no factor while racing three and four wide.
