MYMANROWEN challenged for the early lead, came around the turn on the outside, drove clear down the lane and finished well. NATURAL HIGH unhurried in the early going, raced between rivals around the turn, made a late bid, proved no match for the winner, but outfinished XY FACE for second. XY FACE raced near the middle of the field, came around the turn on the outside, made a wide bid and was outfinished for second. GOLD CAPO void of early speed, raced wide around the turn, showed late interest, but was no factor. WINDTAPPER WIN lacked early speed and passed tired ones. TOMMY SIX FINGERS vied for the early lead and faded inside. AIN'T SO BAD showed early speed and made a steady retreat. DOUBLE BOGEY raced within striking distance, saved ground around the turn and dropped back.
